



Student Catalog Addendum

This catalog addendum supplements the list of accepted documentation of high school graduation or the equivalent in the Admissions section of the Student Catalog.

Attestation of High School Graduation or Its Equivalent:

For the duration of the coronavirus epidemic, if a prospective student applying for admission to ATI is unable to provide the required documentation (transcripts, proof of diploma, GED, college degree, etc.) of their high school graduation or the accepted equivalent, due to a school district, school, or other closure resulting from the epidemic, they may complete an attestation form in the interim. Upon the Campus Director's review and approval, ATI will accept a completed attestation form as temporary proof of high school graduation or the accepted equivalent.

Students completing and signing an attestation form acknowledge their understanding and agreement that as soon as is practicable after the school district/school where they earned their credential reopens and can fulfill such requests, they will promptly cooperate with ATI to obtain documented proof of their high school graduation or its equivalent. If for any reason, an attestation of high school graduation or its equivalent is found to be false or untrue, the student will not have met an ATI admission requirement, will not be considered a regular student and thus, will be subject to immediate dismissal from the school. Furthermore, if an attestation is found to be false or untrue, all Title IV financial aid and any state or institutional financial aid that was distributed on the student's behalf must be refunded to the appropriate source, and the student will be responsible for payment to the school for any and all money refunded including its collection costs and attorneys' fees.
